Doris M. Doll, age 78 of Batesville, died Wednesday, January 23, 2013 at St. Andrew's Health Campus. Born February 8, 1934 in Franklin County Indiana, she is the daughter of Anna (Nee: Brandes) and Valentine Simmermeyer. She married Alois Doll April 28, 1956 at St. Mary's of the Rock Church in St. Mary's, Indiana.
