Evelyn M. Eisert, age 84 of Batesville, died Sunday, May 25, 2014 at The Waters of Batesville. Born April 7, 1930 in Ripley County Indiana, she is the daughter of Hilda (Nee: Kestler) and Ralph Engel. She married Robert Eisert October 16, 1948 and he preceded her in death May 12, 1986. She was a member of St. Paul's Crossroads Lutheran Church and the Batesville V.F.W. Ladies Auxiliary. A homemaker, she also helped run Red's Oasis for nearly twenty years. Evelyn spent much of her time helping others as a volunteer. Many will remember her countless hours working at Margaret Mary Health in addition to driving family and friends to the city for appointments. She also helped raise funds for the Ripley County Heart Fund for many, many years. Like many families from that era, she and Bob raised a garden every year to help feed their large family. Activities she enjoyed included working jigsaw puzzles and traveling. She and Bob were able to make several trips including visits to Las Vegas, Florida and to Canada.
