Sylvia M. Fuentes, age 79 of Batesville, died Tuesday, September 29, 2015 at Christ Hospital in Cincinnati. Born August 25, 1936 in Batesville, she is the daughter of Catherine (Nee: Rahe) and Herman Dickman. She married Cress Fuentes April 19, 1958 at St. Louis Church and he preceded her in death on February 22, 1983. She worked in the housekeeping department at Hillenbrand Industries, retiring in 2000.

Sylvia was a member of St. Louis Church, a former member of the Red Hat Ladies Club and ran with her husband on the Sunman Rescue Squad for 10 years.
