Eugene H. “Geno” Fullenkamp, age 80 of Batesville, died Tuesday, October 3, 2006, at his residence. Born September 13, 1926 in Dayton, Ohio, he is the son of Olivia (Nee: Westgerdes) and Lawrence Fullenkamp. He married Viola Vierling October 14, 1946, at St. Joseph Church in Covington, Kentucky.
