Rita R. Gartenman, age 85 of Batesville, died Friday, July 4, 2008, at Christ Hospital in Cincinnati. Born February 8, 1923 in Oldenburg, Indiana, she is the daughter of Elizabeth (Nee: Lamping) and Joseph Tebbe. She married Arthur Gartenman June 6, 1945, at St. Louis Church in Batesville. Rita worked as an obstetrics technician at Margaret Mary Hospital 33 years before retiring in 1985. She was a member of St. Louis Church, the St. Louis Ladies Society and was a founding member of the St. Louis Bereavement Committee. Rita had many interests over the years.
