Julius C. "Jack" Glaub, age 66 of Batesville, died Saturday, August 26, 2017 at University Hospital in Cincinnati. Born December 24, 1950 in Batesville, he is the son of Bertha (Nee: Wilhelm) and John Glaub Sr. He worked 42 years at the Hill-Rom Company as an electronics assembler before retiring in 2012.

Jack liked the outdoors. He was an avid fisherman and according to his family could out fish everyone. His other favorite activity was bike riding. It was common to see him, usually daily, out riding. Jack was also an accomplished wood worker and enjoyed making clocks and was a long time member of St. Anthony's Choir.
