Wilbur Jackson Jr, age 68 of Oldenburg, died Monday, March 28, 2016 at Margaret Mary Health. Born June 21, 1947 in Hamilton, Ohio, he is the son of Juanita (Nee: Johnson) and Wilbur Jackson Sr. He served in the army during the Vietnam war and after the service became a welder. Although a welder by trade, he was a jack of all trades that could fix most anything.

In his free time Wilbur loved being outdoors. He was an avid fisherman and gardener. He'd recently built hot boxes for the family and helped grow 50 tomato plants which were either canned or turned into juice. Several years ago he took in a stray kitten he named Frisky.
