Margaret C. Kidwell, age 75 of Cincinnati and formerly of Batesville, died Saturday, October 10, 2015 at St. Margaret Hall in Cincinnati. She worked as an X-ray technician for Good Samaritan Hospital and Supervisor of Staffing for Jewish Hospital in Cincinnati as well as managing the Dairy Queen in Batesville.
