Agnes E. Kuhn, age 100 of Batesville, died Monday, February 27, 2012 at The Waters of Batesville. Born November 22, 1911 in St. Peter's, Indiana, she is the daughter of Mary (Nee: Metz) and George Ripperger. She married Edward Kuhn Sr. August 30, 1933 at St. Peter's Church in St. Peter's and he preceded her in death on April 8, 1984.
