**E**mil A. Kuntz, age 85 of Oldenburg, Indiana, died Tuesday, December 13, 2016 at St. Andrews Health Campus in Batesville. Born June 15, 1931, he is the son of Veronica (Nee: Meyer) and William Kuntz. He married Patricia Welsh on June 9, 1956 at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Mayslick, Kentucky. Emil was an Army veteran serving his country during the Korean War. He was a lifelong farmer and drove a school bus for a few years for the Batesville Community School Corporation. Emil loved spending time outdoors whether it was working on his farm, taking a stroll through the woods or cutting firewood.
