Aiden K. Mehlbauer, age 4 of Metamora, Indiana, died Wednesday, February 16, 2011 at Children's Hospital in Cincinnati. Born October 24, 2006 in Batesville, he is the son of Shavonne (Nee: Zins) and Gregory Mehlbauer. Aiden was all boy. He was active, inquisitive, cuddly and mischievous all rolled into one. He had a sweet, natural smile, but his parents said "whenever he came up and out of nowhere said I love you, it was time to look around and found out what he'd done." He liked to play outside and loved going to grandpa's farm to help feed the cows. He was a fan of the Cincinnati Bengals as well as Sponge Pants Bob and Buzz and Woody from "Toy Story."
