Fred C. Metz, age 69 of Batesville, died Friday, May 15, 2009, at his residence. Born October 24, 1939 in Batesville, he is the son of Magdalen (Nee: Billman) and Frederick L. Metz. He married Janet Raver June 19, 1965 at Holy Family Church in Oldenburg. He served in the Navy from 1962 to 1964. Fred was a machinist for General Electric and K.S. Bearings before retiring in 2004. He was a member of the Batesville Knights of Columbus #1461, Oldenburg Conservation Club and the Prell-Bland American Legion Post #271. Fred enjoyed the outdoors. In his earlier years he liked to hunt for rabbits and other small game and go fishing as well. In later years he preferred to go golfing and regularly played at the Cricket Ridge Golf Course. At a young age, he developed an interest for trap shooting which he stayed active with throughout his life and spent many hours at the Oldenburg Conservation Club doing.
