Adrian F. Meyer, age 79 of Batesville, Indiana, died Tuesday, December 16, 2008, at Margaret Mary Community Hospital in Batesville. Born April 8, 1929 in Batesville, he is the son of Amelia (Nee: Waechter) and Frank Meyer. Adrian was a truck driver for the Batesville Casket Company and was an Army veteran in the Korean War. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #3183 and was presently the Post Commander. He was also a Fourth Degree member of the Knights of Columbus Council #1461, Prell-Bland American Legion Post #271 and Holy Family Catholic Church. He is survived by his wife Linda S.
