William R. Moeller, age 64 of Batesville, died Sunday, September 23, 2007 at Margaret Mary Community Hospital. Born August 19, 1943 in Batesville, he is the son of Opal (Nee: Waltermann) and Herman Moeller. He married Leona Kinker November 28, 1964 at St. John's Catholic Church in Enochsburg, Indiana. Bill was an Airplane Mechanic for Hillenbrand Industries for 42 years, before retiring in January 2006.
