Frederick R. "Fred" Schene, age 58 of Oldenburg, Indiana, died Saturday, October 24, 2009 at Margaret Mary Community Hospital in Batesville, Indiana. Born December 1, 1950 in Batesville, he is the son of Mildred (Nee: Goldsmith) and Alvin Schene. Fred married Catherine Doll, his life partner, on March 14, 1972 at St. Louis Catholic Church in Batesville. Fred was a U.S Navy Vietnam War veteran, a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #3183 and a 3rd degree member of the Knights of Columbus Council #1461. Over the years, he was an avid softball umpire and every chance he had, you could find him at his real passion, on the golf course, playing golf with his family and friends. He bartended for years at Red's Oasis in Morris and later worked at Cricket Ridge Golf Course as a groundskeeper and bartender.
