Maurice C. Schoettelkotte, age 80 of Oldenburg, died Friday, March 6, 2015 at Christ Hospital in Cincinnati. Born February 3, 1935 in Batesville, he is the son of Regina (Nee: Roehm) and John Schoettelkotte. He married Eva Fields August 29, 1959 at Holy Family Church in Oldenburg. Maurice served in the army from 1954 - 1956 stationed overseas. After the service he would spend 33 years as a truck driver for the Nobbe/Straber Oil Co.

Many of Maurice's activities took him outdoors. He liked taking the family on camping vacations to different parts of the country. He also enjoyed fishing, raised a large garden each year and doing yard work, especially mowing. His family teased that each time he got a new riding mower, it was bigger than the than previous one. The kids also mentioned Maurice was a good cook known for his fried chicken. He put those skills to use at the annual church picnic, having helped with the chicken frying for years.
