Agnes T. Smith, age 83 of Batesville, Indiana, died Saturday, October 2, 2010 at the St. Andrews Health Campus in Batesville. Born May 1, 1927 in Batesville, she is the daughter of Agnes (Nee: Schwenen) and Henry Fieler. On August 3, 1974, she married Ross Smith at St. John's Catholic Church in Enochsburg, Indiana bringing two families together as one and he preceded her in death on December 4, 2003. Agnes lived nearly her entire life in the same house in which she was born on Mulberry Street. With the help of her father, she raised her three boys while working as a grocery clerk at A&P then later at Kroger's. She also worked at the Eagle's lodge in Batesville where she met Ross.
