Glen W. Smith, age 50 of Batesville, died Saturday, May 21, 2016. Born December 10, 1965 in Madison, Indiana, he is the son of Della (Nee: Watts) and William Smith. He married Judy Amberger September 8, 1990 at St. Mary's of the Rock Church. He was a driver for UPS 28 years and a member of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local #135.

Judy teased that he fancied himself a ladies' man. He loved having people at the house and entertaining.
