## Mary E. Vogelsang

Mary E. Vogelsang, age 82 of Batesville, died Friday, December 12, 2008 at her home. Born April 26, 1926 in Batesville, she is the daughter of Caroline (Nee: Ollier) and Leo Walke. She married Marvin Vogelsang September 27, 1952 at St. Louis Catholic Church and he preceded her in death on January 8, 2008.
