Raymond J. Volk, age 91 of Batesville, died Tuesday, May 12, 2009 at The Waters of Dillsboro. Born February 1, 1918 in Decatur Co. Indiana, he is the son of Rosa (Nee: Litmer) and Frank Volk. He married Bernice Clayton June 27, 1946 at St. Maurice Church in St. Maurice, Indiana and she preceded him in death on December 5, 1996.
