Becky A. Werner, age 55 of Batesville, Indiana, died Monday, September 3, 2007 at her home. Born in Hamilton, Ohio in 1952, she is the daughter of Charlotte (Nee: Nistler) and Albert Orschell. She married Dale Werner on September 16, 1978 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Brookville, Indiana. Becky was a buyer specialist/purchasing agent for the Hill-Rom Co. for 28 years.
