Floyd J. Werner, age 80 of Oldenburg, died Monday, May 22, 2017 at his home. Born March 28, 1937 in Franklin County Indiana, he is the son of Clara (Nee: Hartman) and Carl Werner. He served in the army between the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War and was the long time owner of Floyd Werner Concrete and the Oldenburg Lumber Company. He also farmed, was a member of the Southeastern Indiana Home Builders Association and a former member of the Eagle Fire Company.

Although Floyd had many interests, baseball was his passion. He played and managed in the Tri-County League for over 20 years, thoroughly enjoyed watching his grandkids play ball and was an avid Reds fan as well. When it was time to put his spikes and glove away, he took up golf and for years hosted the Floyd Werner Golf Tournament. He was a long time league bowler in Oldenburg as well as a Cleveland Browns fan. According to his family, Floyd looked forward to business trips in Vegas or Atlantic City, where he could stop off to try his luck at the casinos. They also said he was fearless, willing to take on building projects others were afraid to attempt.
