**J**oan M. Wissel, age 80 of Batesville, died Sunday, November 20, 2011 at Margaret Mary Hospital. Born January 2, 1931 in Cincinnati, Ohio, she is the daughter of Luetta (Nee: Schwartz) and August Meyer. She married Carl Wissel May 21, 1955 at Little Flower Church in Cincinnati and he preceded her in death January 15, 2011. She was a member of Holy Family Church, the Daughters of Isabella and the V.F.W. Ladies Auxiliary. Joan was proud to serve as a Registered Nurse for forty years. She attended St. Elizabeth's School of Nursing in Covington, Kentucky and after earning her degree worked at Drake Hospital in Cincinnati.
