Charles J. Bentfield, age 79 of Batesville, died Wednesday, March 28, 2018 at Christ Hospital in Cincinnati. Born April 19, 1938 in Batesville, he is the son of Olivia (Nee: Ferkinhoff) and Bertrand Bentfield. He married Elaine Wallpe February 20, 1965 at St. Anthony's Church in Morris. Chuck followed his dad's profession as a barber, taking over his father's business when he was 20 years old. He was owner of Bentfield's Hair Care for over 55 years, retiring in 2015. He was a member of the Batesville Knights of Columbus Council #1461 and the Batesville Eagles Aerie #1130.
