## **Marguerite R. Williamson**

**M**arguerite R. Williamson, age 73 of Morris, died Sunday, December 24, 2017 at her home. Born October 27, 1944 in Casey County Kentucky, she is the daughter of Hazel (Nee: Davis) and Charles Norman. She married Dave Williamson April 25, 1975 in Milan, Indiana. Marguerite worked at the Hill-Rom Company as an assembler 33 years before retiring in 2007. She also worked in housekeeping at Hillenbrand's corporate office from 2012 – 2016.

The most important things in Marguerite's life were faith and family. She regularly read her bible and taught Sunday school at four churches in addition to holding Sunday school for the grandkids in her kitchen. She cherished spending time with her children and grandchildren. According to her family, Marguerite was a good cook. Her fried chicken was especially good and served every Sunday. Apparently though, she had quite a sweet tooth and often would skip over the meal and go directly for the dessert.

She is survived by her husband Dave; daughters Cheryl (Mike) Leach of Bixby, Oklahoma, Lori (Pete) Smoke of Spavinaw, Oklahoma; sons Steven (Melissa), Jeffery and Matthew (Susan) Williamson, all of Batesville; mother Hazel Norman of Sunman; sister Hilda Powell of Batesville; brothers Jim Norman of Sunman, John Norman of Batesville, Don Norman of Sunman; eighteen grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
