Louis E. Schwegman, age 65 of Oldenburg, died Monday, May 21, 2018 at his home. Born July 5, 1952 in Batesville, he is the son of Marcella (Nee: Rennekamp) and Lawrence Schwegman. He married Mary Willhelm June 12, 1976 at Holy Guardian Angel Church in Cedar Grove, Indiana and she died November 22, 2000. He married Carol Werner May 14, 2004 at St. Mary's of the Rock Church in St. Mary's, Indiana. Louie was a lifelong farmer and built homes for many years with Hartman Construction before starting Schwegman and Schwegman Construction Company.

Farming was Louie's passion and he was a huge Allis-Chalmers fan. A ride in the country or vacations were an opportunity to check out how other farmer's fields were doing. He raised Holstein cattle as well and was proud that one his granddaughters' had the Grand Champion Steer at last year's county fair. 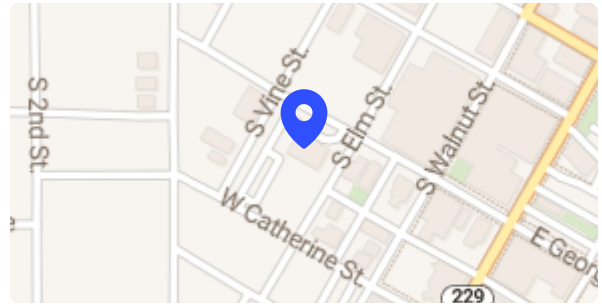

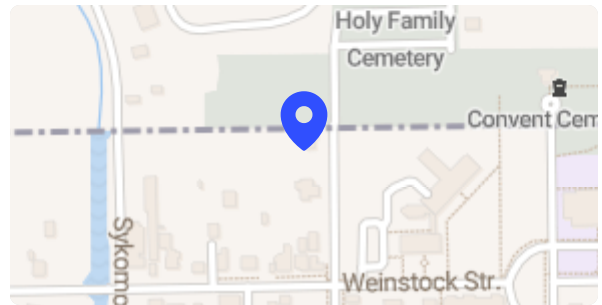
