On Thursday May 31st, 2018 Nicholas L Stewart died in Batesville IN and met the Lord. Nick was born to Adam and Helen Stewart Westrick on December 24th, 1933. Upon his mother's death shortly after his birth, he was adopted and raised by his grandparents, Leota and George Stewart. Nick married Mary Baker on Sept 7th, 1957 and she preceded him in death on March 15th, 1998. Nick is survived by three daughters and their husbands: Patricia and Kurt Rauscher, Pamela and Lakish Hatakar and Elizabeth and John Ruehl and three grandchildren: Maryasha Hatakar, Michael Rauscher and Daniel Rauscher. Dad would remind us, "I won't be gone. I will just have gone ahead of you."

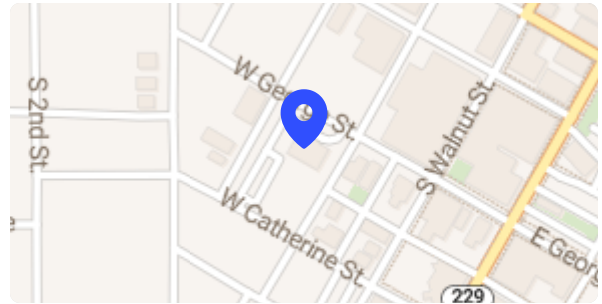

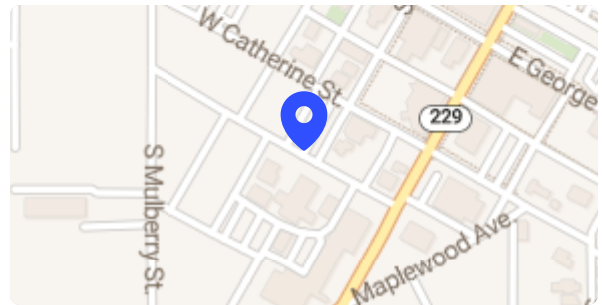
