Carol L. Bergman, age 62 of Batesville, died Monday, December 24, 2018 at her home. Born November 10, 1956 in Batesville, she is the daughter of Leona (Nee: Kinker) and Donald Meyer. She married Dennis Bergman July 17, 1976 at St. Louis Church. She was a long time administrative assistant for the Batesville Middle School.

Family was extremely important to Carol. A devoted mother, her children were her priority and later her grandchildren proved to be the greatest joy in her life. 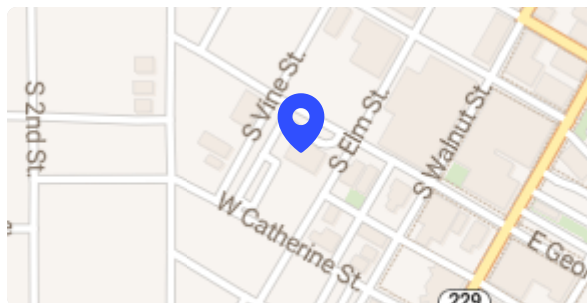

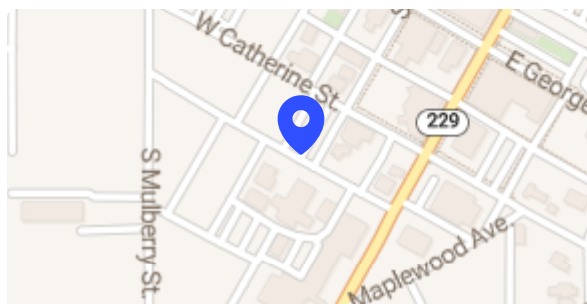

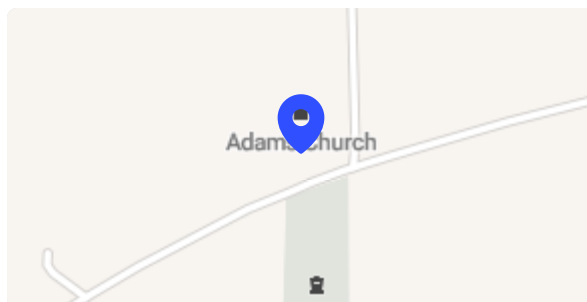
