Jane C. Fullenkamp, age 80 of Oldenburg, died Friday, March 20, 2020 at her home. Born July 20, 1939 in Batesville, she is the daughter of Helen (Nee: Doll) and Louis Dietz. She married Edward Fullenkamp April 4, 1959 at St. Louis Church and worked behind the butcher counter at the Village Store for 20 years. Eddie preceded her in death October 28, 2006.

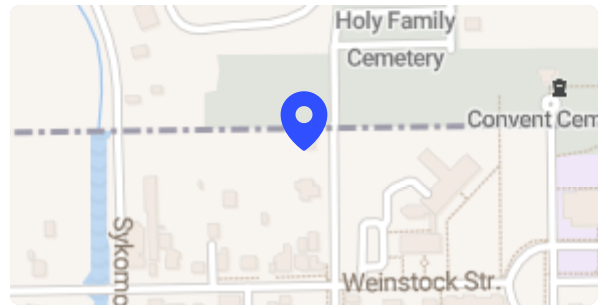
