U PDATE: Due to the COVID restrictions at the time of Eunice's death, the Governor's mandate limited her services to immediate family. With larger social gatherings being allowed, the family would like to invite you to join them 10 a.m. Saturday, June 20th, for a memorial mass at St. Louis Church. Following the service, a Celebration of Life will be held St. Peter's Parish Hall in St. Peter's.

Eunice F. Miller, age 84 of Batesville, died Friday, March 20, 2020 at her home. Born November 5, 1935 in Franklin County Indiana, she is the daughter of Bertha (Nee: Geis) and William Metz. She worked 19 years at the Hill-Rom Company as an assembler.

Family was most important to Eunice and she dearly loved having her children and grandchildren with her. Very devout, her religion was also important to her.
