Virginia F. Bedel, age 81 of Batesville, died Thursday, April 16, 2020 at her home. Born September 21, 1938 in Batesville, she is the daughter of Mary Jane (Nee: Kirschbaum) and Vincent Herbert. She married Lawrence Bedel February 2, 1957 at St. Louis Church and he preceded her in death on September 7, 2015. Ginny was a finish inspector for the Union Furniture Company and later at Romweber's Furniture.

Ginny loved people. She never met a stranger and truly enjoyed talking with people. She did quite a bit of quilting and needlepoint over the years, was a long-suffering Bengals fan and loved working in her flower gardens. Ginny was a good cook and her family will certainly miss her zucchini bread.
