Lawrence P. Enzinger, age 72 of Batesville, died Saturday, October 30, 2021 at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis. Born July 9, 1949 in Batesville, he is the son of Virginia (Nee: Seevers) and Paul Enzinger Sr. He married Joyce Holland October of 1975 in Dillsboro. Larry worked at Doyle Heating Company for several years before going to work at Batesville Casket Company for over 25 years before retiring in 2015.

Many of Larry's interests took him outdoors. He loved to go fishing and golfing in addition to playing softball for many years. Although he was a Reds fan, he enjoyed watching sports of all sorts and often could be found in the crowd of his nieces' and nephews' sporting events. Larry and Joyce liked to travel, with Gatlinburg and Destin, Florida being their favorite destinations. 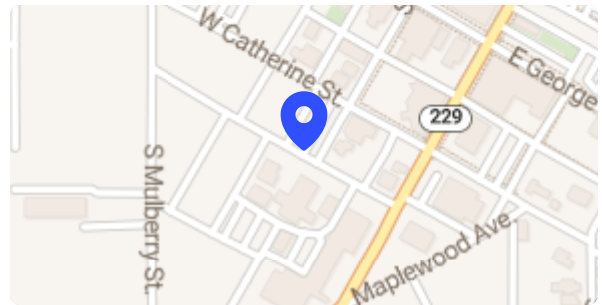
