Cornelia C. “Cornie” Hoffman, age 78 of Dover, died Sunday, November 14, 2021 at St. Elizabeth Dearborn Hospital. Born December 26, 1942 in Ripley County Indiana, she is the daughter of Bessie (Nee: Grills) and Paul Wissel. She married Conrad Hoffman May 9, 1964 at St. Anthony’s Church in Morris. She was the Senior Branch Administrator at Edward Jones for nearly 20 years.

Cornie had two passions. She loved spending time with her family and was extremely fond of cats. She also enjoyed working in the garden, raising flowers, embroidering and made baby quilts for many in the family. Work was never far from her mind though, as she followed the financial reports and the market daily. 




