# Mary A. Thornsberry

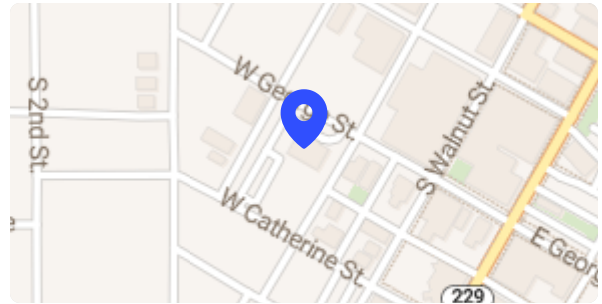

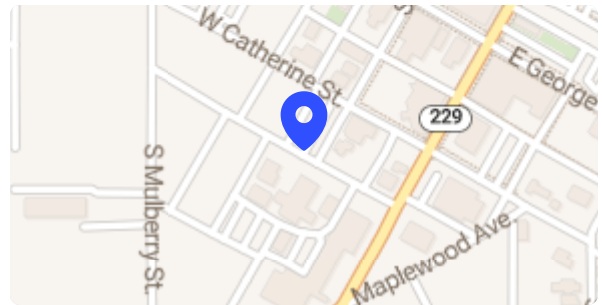
