Elizabeth A. Gigrich, age 79 of Batesville, died Tuesday, September 27, 2022 at her home. Born September 3, 1943 in Richmond, Indiana, she is the daughter of Catherine (Nee: Zins) and Urban Baker. She married James Gigrich September 7, 1963 at St. Mary's of the Rock Church.

Elizabeth was generous with her time, volunteering countless hours at Oldenburg Academy and St. Louis Cafeteria as well as serving on the St. Louis Bereavement committee for years. Her greatest joy was spending time with her grandchildren and attending their sporting events and activities. She also had a long-standing habit of texting each of them daily. Elizabeth took pride in keeping her house, flower gardens and car neat, clean and tidy. Through the years she did quite a bit of quilting and embroidering and always looked forward getting together with her coffee club. She and Jim enjoyed traveling. 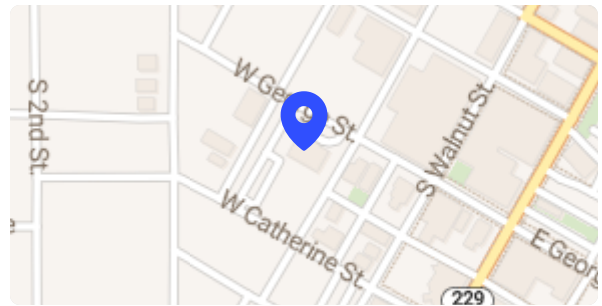

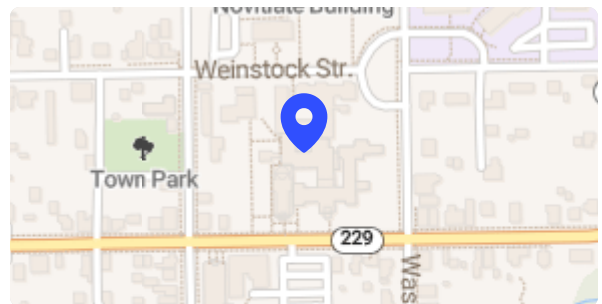
