Sandra “Sandy” Koch passed away peacefully on Tuesday, February 7th, 2023, surrounded by her family. Born April 17, 1951 in Batesville, she is the daughter of Leonida (Nee: Kellerman) and Gilbert Munchel. She married Ron Koch Sr. on May 6, 1972 at Holy Family Church and he preceded her in death April 12, 2000.




