**N**ancy Ollier, of Batesville IN, passed away peacefully, surrounded by her family, on June 23, 2023. She was 78

Nancy was born in Batesville, March 13, 1945 to Melvin and Rita Maple. She was one of four siblings, having a sister and two brothers.

She would go on to graduate from Oldenburg Academy, becoming a teacher at St. Louis Elementary School. It was there she would meet her husband of 57 years and love of her life, Gerald Ollier, whom at the time was working as a janitor at the school.

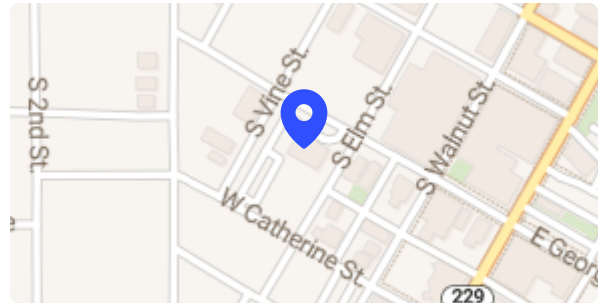

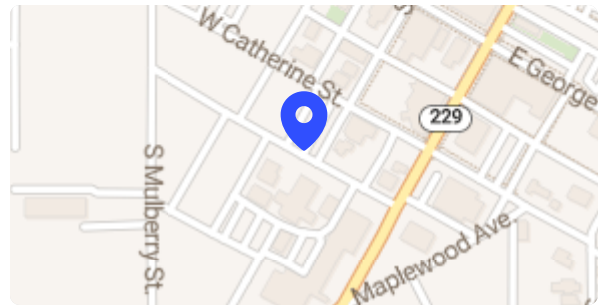
