# Shirley E. McDaniel

**S**hirley E. McDaniel, age 73 of Batesville, formerly of North Judson, Indiana, died Wednesday, July 5, 2023 at Our Hospice of South Central Indiana in Columbus, Indiana. Born December 11, 1949 in Starke County Indiana, she is the daughter of Elsie (Nee: Saine) and Morris Fredrick Madsen. 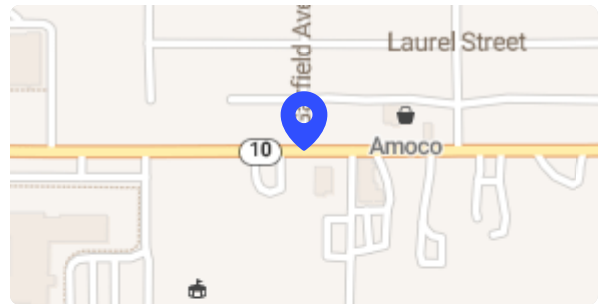

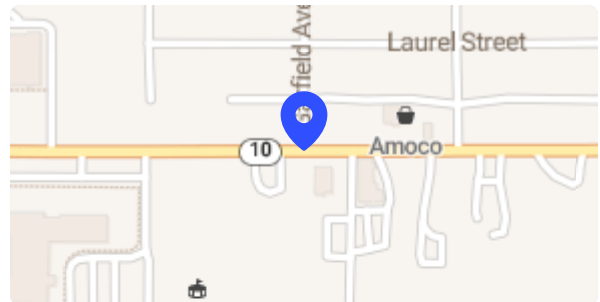
