Evelyn L. Niese, age 80 of Morris, Indiana, passed away peacefully in her sleep Saturday, March 23, 2024, at her home. Born April 11, 1943, in Mishawaka, Indiana, she is the daughter of Eunice Fecher. She married Eugene H. Niese on April 8, 1967, at St. Louis Catholic Church in Batesville and he preceded her in death on September 8, 2012.

Evelyn loved her grandsons and would have them watch her shows like Walker Texas Ranger, Supernatural or NCIS with her. She was an avid fan of wrestling (which you did not argue it is not fake per her), her favorite was the Undertaker and Roman Reigns. She was a member of the Silver Sneakers at Anytime Fitness, going three times a week and she loved her trainers there. Her favorite holiday was Christmas, and she would sometimes wear Christmas shirts all year round. 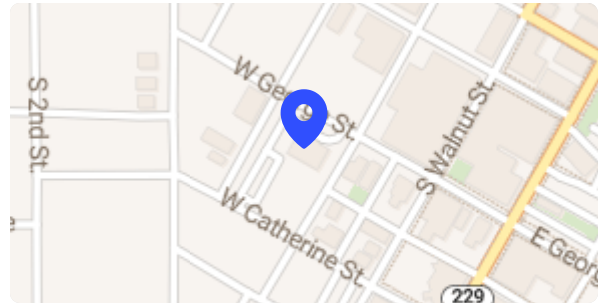
