## **Greg M. Lindemann**

**G**reg M. Lindemann, age 72 of Batesville, Indiana, passed away on Wednesday, September 11, 2024, at the University of Cincinnati Medical Center in Cincinnati, Ohio. Born April 2, 1952, in Batesville, he is the son of Luther and Juanita (Nee: Wonning) Lindemann. Greg married Kris Schumacher on June 26, 1976, at St. Louis Church in Batesville. Greg was a faithful member and volunteer at St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Batesville and owned and operated Lindemann Appliances in Batesville for many years, before retiring.

Greg lived by way of faith, joy, and altruism. Volunteering was part of his nature and everyday life. Whether it be with the local food pantry, helping a neighbor, or his time with the Batesville Fire Department, Greg was loyal to his community. 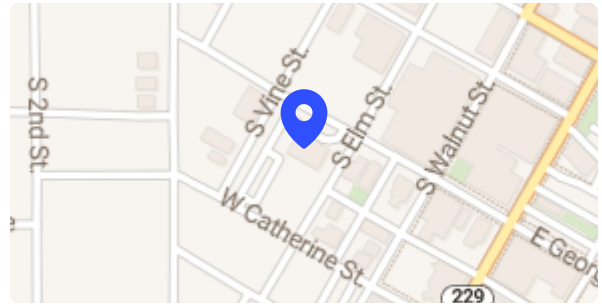

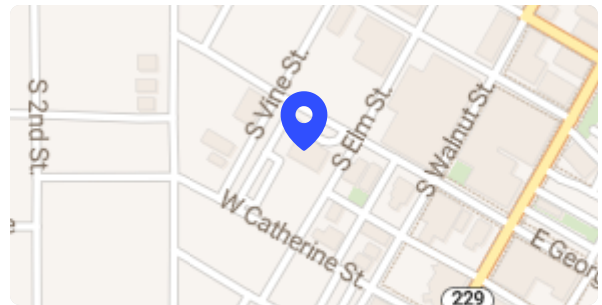
