Mildred "Millie" Ann Cutter of Batesville, Indiana, passed away peacefully at home on Monday September 16, 2024, surrounded by family. Born in Batesville, Indiana on January 6, 1933, and would marry Melvin Walter Cutter on October 7, 1961, at St. Mary's of the Rock Church in St. Mary's, Indiana. Melvin preceded her in death on December 17, 2020. She was also preceded in death by her parents, Leo and Anna (nee: Rosfeld) Theobald and sisters Thelma Eckstein and Ruth Siefert.
