Rosemary Wenning, age 94 of Batesville, Indiana, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, at The Chateau of Batesville. Born January 28, 1930, in Indianapolis, Indiana, she is the daughter of William and Clara (Nee: Bohman) Giltz. She married Clement “Ralph” Wenning on May 5, 1956, at St. Louis Catholic Church in Batesville and he preceded her in death on April 8, 2019. Rosie was a Teacher’s Assistant for several area schools, before retiring. She was a member of St. Louis Catholic Church and its lady’s society, Daughters of Isabella, and the Rosie Red’s Club.

Rosemary’s faith was very important to her. Before her health failed you always saw her at 9:30 am mass on Sunday in the same spot! She often attended the weekly daily mass and enjoyed seeing the students of St. Louis School there.

Rosemary loved her grandchildren and was adamant about attending all their extracurricular activities, including soccer, which she never understood! She enjoyed music – especially Christmas music – and attended many live performances with her children, grandchildren and other groups. 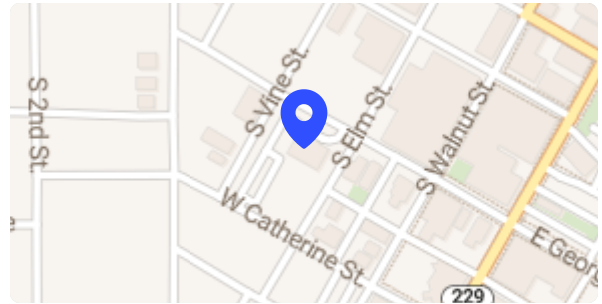

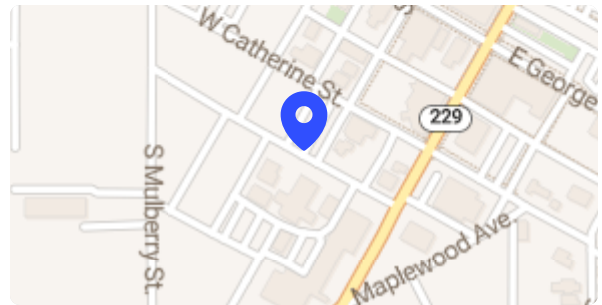
