**S**tanley Trojak, age 95 of Harrison, Ohio, passed away on Wednesday, March 5, 2025, at St. Andrews Health Campus in Batesville, Indiana. Born January 12, 1930, in Chicago, Illinois, he is the son of John and Caroline (Nee: Krezel) Trojak. He married Valerie Dominick on September 1, 1956, at St. Richard's Church in Chicago and she preceded him in death on April 5, 2006.
