Born July 19, 1952, in Batesville, she is the daughter of Edward John and Arvilla (nee Stevens) Schumacher. She was married to Greg Monty Lindemann on June 26th, 1976, at St. Louis Catholic Church in Batesville, Indiana.

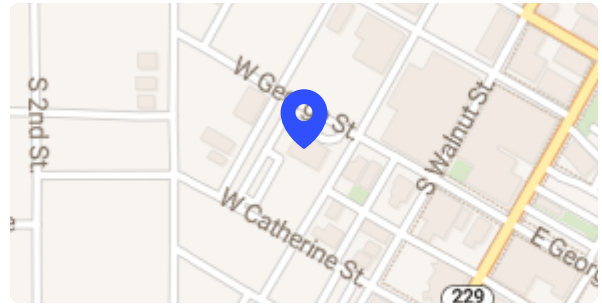

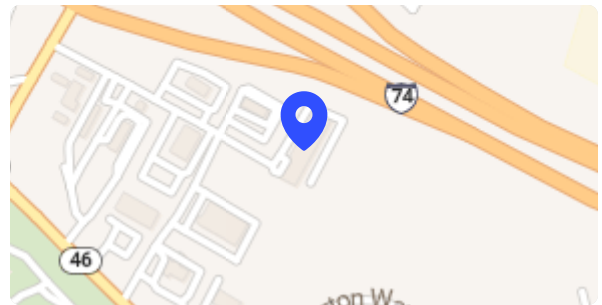

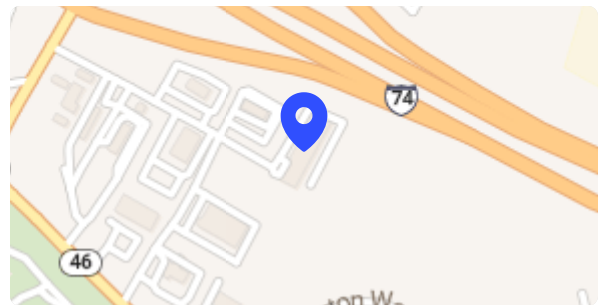
