John Albert Bunselmeier, 79, of Osgood, passed away Friday, March 6, 2026, at St. Andrews Health Campus in Batesville.

John was born July 26, 1946, in Batesville, the son of Albert John and Viola (Meyer) Bunselmeier. He graduated from Jac-Cen-Del High School in 1964 and went on to attend Sam's Technical School, where he became a licensed electrician. In 1968, John enlisted in the Air Force Reserves.
