Jaeger Alden Rose, age 29, of Connersville, Indiana, passed away on Tuesday, April 21, 2026, at the University of Cincinnati Medical Center in Cincinnati, Ohio. Born on May 30, 1996, in Oxford, Ohio, he was the son of the late Jason Rose and Bettina (née Hanson) Rose-Ronnebaum. 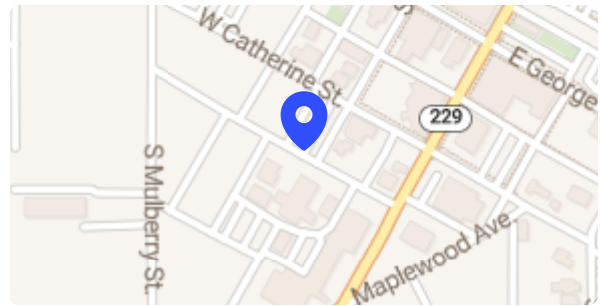
